

1. Club Championships

The Saltire Rally Club shall organise four Club Championships as follows:

- Club Championship
- Junior Championship
- Smartloos Autotest Championship
- Nicolson Digital Navigational Championship

2. Eligibility

The Championships are open to all bona fide members of the Saltire Rally Club Limited (SRC) and no specific registration is required.

Points will only be awarded to bona fide members of the Saltire Rally Club Limited.

The Junior Championship is open to all SRC members under 18 years at the start of the first championship event in any one year.

Points for the Smartloos Autotest Championship and the Nicolson Digital Navigational Championship will be extracted from the main championship for events counting for those championships.

3. Entries for Events

Event regulations and entry forms will be distributed by email to all members and will also be available on the SRC Website and Facebook page.

4. Number of Events to Count

For the Club Championship and the Junior Championship the number of events that count towards a competitor's final score is one less than the total number of events run.

For example, if 12 events run in a championship, only the best 11 scores will count.

For the Smartloos Autotest Championship and the Nicolson Digital Navigational Championship all qualifying events will count.

5. Points System

A straight 10, 9, 8,.... points system will be used based on overall positions. If the event has a multiple permit the results from all permits will be merged.

All starters in an event will score 1 point. This is in addition to any score from their finishing position.

e.g. The winner will score 10 +1 = 11 points.

Events with different level of instruction, e.g. Expert, Non Expert, Novice etc. will be merged and taken as a single class.

In any event where non members are eligible to compete, the scoring will only take account of members and results of non-members will be ignored.

In Autotest events points will be allocated as follow:

Drivers will score points as above, i.e. 11, 10, 9, 8,.....

Passengers will score one point for one entry only.



Named Event Officials, who by virtue of their role are unable to compete as well as officiate, plus Opening, Closing and Strip-Down Crews will score 10 points for the first event on which they officiate, 5 for the second event and 1 point thereafter.

For the Smartloos and Nicolson Digital Championships, if any competitor acts as a Named Official or as Set-Up or Strip-Down crew they will be credited with 10 points for that round. Only one such score shall be counted.

Members will score 1 point for each event on which they marshal.

Note that all competitors must marshal or officiate on at least one event to qualify for the Championships.

For the Club, Smartloos and Nicolson Digital Championships points will be awarded to all eligible competitors.

For the Junior Championship points will be awarded by considering the results of the Junior competitors only. i.e The highest placed Junior will score 11, the second highest 10, and so on.

6. Best Performance only to count

Where a competitor enters more than once in any event, then only their best performance in that event shall count for points. Their other entries shall still be included in the results and in the calculation of other competitors' points.

If a competitor is entered once as a passenger and once as a driver in the same event (e.g. PCA) then both scores shall count but these will be treated as separate scores so only the best 11 scores from whatever source will be counted (or whatever number of counting events is appropriate for the number of events run).

7. Ties in Events

In the event of a tie for a place on an event, ties shall be resolved following the method defined in the Standard Regulations for that event.

8. Ties in Championship

In the event of a tie in any section for an award, the award shall be given to the competitor with the greatest total score without dropping scores. If there is still a tie the award shall be given to the competitor gaining the greater number of first placings, then the number of second and subsequent placings shall be considered. To be eligible for any championship competitors must obtain 2 or more scores in that championship. Any disputes will be resolved at the discretion of the committee.

9. Smartloos Autotest Championship

This Championship shall be for Drivers only in Autotest Events.

Qualifying Events in the Championship Schedule below are 1,5,7 & 8.

10. Nicolson Digital Navigational Championship

This Championship shall be for Drivers and Navigators in Events where there is significant Navigation, e.g 12 Cars, Navigational Rallies, Navigational Scatters or Treasure Hunts.



Qualifying Events in the Championship Schedule below are 2,4,6 & 10.
