1. Announcement

Saltire Rally Club will organise the Eco Wander Touring Assembly / Treasure Hunt on Sunday 2nd August 26.

The event will start and finish at John Clark Motors, Broomhill Road Dundee The route will follow the same roads as the International EV Rally starting prior to this event. Timings shown are subject to change.

2. Jurisdiction

The event will be held under the National Competition Rules of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), and these Supplementary Regulations, together with any other written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

3. Authorisation

Motorsport UK Exemption Certificate No 208228 has been issued.

4. Championships

The event will be a qualifying round of the following Championships in accordance with the relevant event regulations;

- a) Saltire Rally Club Championship (Saltire RC members only)
- b) Nicolson Digital Saltire Navigational Championship (Saltire RC members only)

5. Crew Eligibility

The event is open to members of the Saltire Rally Club and Caledonian Classic & Historic Motor Sport Club.

Competitors must produce an RS Clubman licence or higher and valid club membership card at Documentation.

6. Programme

Entries close at 22:00 on Thursday 30th July 2026

Competitor information will be issued from 10:00 hrs on Sunday 2nd August 2026

The event will start at John Clark Motors, Broomhill Road Dundee

All cars must be back at the start point by 17:00 hrs

7. Route Instructions and Timecards

- A Basic Road Book will be provided
- No white roads may be used.
- The same section of road may be used more than once.
- Competitors are wholly responsible for submitting their Treasure Hunt answers at the finish.

8. Classes

The event is open to any road legal car, EV, Hybrid, Petrol or Diesel.
