Taking us to Brechin Castle for the first time, a venue new to the rally community, we are setting out a mixed surface stage, tarmac at the start before turning to typical Scottish gravel. The stage has a variety of different corners and elevation changes, will genuinely be fun to drive and quite a challenge in places.

Following the action on Saturday evening, there will be a social event, with each two day entry receiving a ticket and meal. Whilst we consider that a two day entry would be better for drivers, it is possible to enter for one day only.

Car eligibility will be the same as our other events. Should you suffer car problems on Saturday, there will be no refund for your Sunday entry. Two drivers can share your rally car, but we ask that cleaning of the inside of the car be carried out between changes. A separate entry will be needed for both drivers.

There will be a short lunch break on both days and various food options will be available. Food and Beverages will be available at all times during the day.

We will be adding both displays of classic and sports cars. We see running an event at Brechin Castle as a long term prospect, with the potential to make this another very large gathering. There is a lot of space, with a number of spectating spots available, with easy access from all directions, particularly on the A90 from Dundee to Aberdeen.

The entry fee is £225.00 for Sunday only, £375.00 for Saturday and Sunday, including entry to the Saturday evening social. If entering for two days, one extra ticket for the evening event without a meal is available, without charge. Extra meals can be purchased at cost. Scrutineering will not take place, we will ask you to self-certify to the condition of your car, but a light safety check will be carried out. Stage passports and in-date equipment are not required, nor are Competition Licences. If your car has a Passport please provide the number, that is only for our records. Helmets must be worn, however there is no requirement for them to be in date. We will check that suitable fire extinguishers are in place and you must have a SOS/OK board in the car.

HANS devices and Balaclavas are not required for Historic Rally Cars to take part in a Demonstration event. You are free to use if you wish. You do not have to wear overalls, but we prefer that you do to enhance the event for spectators. Cars not complying with current stage rally rules are welcome, such as Targa or Road Rally cars, or cars complying with older rally car regulations, please simply

advise the organisers of your car. If its basic model is less than 20 years old, please contact the organisers also.
