

	Supplementary Regulations The Moonless Wander Treasure Hunt Sunday 6th September 26	
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1. Announcement

Saltire Rally Club will organise the Moonless Wander Treasure Hunt on 6th September 2026.
The event will start and finish at Perth Arms, High Street, Dunkeld, PH8 0AJ.

2. Jurisdiction

The event will be held under the National Competition Rules of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), and these Supplementary Regulations, together with any other written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

3. Authorisation

Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption: 208767

4. Championships

The event will be a qualifying round of the following Championships in accordance with the relevant event regulations;

- a) Saltire Rally Club Championship (Saltire RC members only)
- b) Nicolson Digital Saltire Navigational Championship (Saltire RC members only)

5. Crew Eligibility

The event is open to members of the organising club.

Competitors must produce an RS Clubman licence or higher and valid club membership card at Documentation.

6. Programme

Signing On will take place electronically at Rallyscore.net.

Entries close at 21:00 on Wednesday 2nd September 2026.

Competitor information will be issued from 10:30 on Sunday 6th September 2026.

The event will start at 11:00 on Sunday 6th September 2026.

All cars must be back at the start point by 16:00 on Sunday 6th September 2026.

7. Route Instructions and Timecards

The Route will be contained on OS Landranger Map 53.

Any feature of the map, legend or cardboard cover may be used to define the route to be followed.

- There is no fixed route but mileage is expected to be between 60 and 90 miles on public roads.
- No white roads may be used.
- The same section of road may be used more than once.
- Competitors are wholly responsible for submitting their results sheets at the finish.

8. Classes

The event is open to any road legal car.

Car with 2 Adults - £35 Entry Fee

Car with at least one junior member £25



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9. Awards

An award will be made to the best placed crew.

10. Entries

Entries open on issue of these Supplementary Regulations.

Entries close at 21:00hrs on Wednesday 2nd September. The entry fee is £35

The maximum entry for the meeting is 35. The minimum is 10.

Should the minimum figure not be reached the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting.

11. Final Instructions

12. Passenger Requirements

No restrictions, but for fairness two adults only.

13. Safeguarding & Competitors under the age of 18

Any Competitor under the age of 18 must:

a) Have their entry form countersigned by a parent or guardian.

b) Have a Parent or Guardian complete the Parental Consent Form On-Line

PLEASE NOTE. If there is no Parental or Guardian consent in accordance with the above, then those under 18 years of age cannot be permitted to take part in the event.

15. Scoring

Competitors will start with zero marks. For each location visited, and the question for that location correctly answered, points will be awarded as detailed on the route instructions. Different locations will accrue different scores.

A maximum score of 24 points from answering questions will be counted.

A mileage reading will be taken at the start and at the finish. The mileage covered will be compared to an “ideal mileage”. For every mile covered in excess of the “ideal mileage” a point will be deducted.

Classification will be by reference to total marks scored.

In the event of a tie, the competitor who has covered the shortest distance will be the winner.

16. Results

Provisional results will be declared in accordance with [\(NCR.3.6.1.1b\)](#)

Results will become final when the protest time has expired, or all outstanding protests and appeals have been settled. A copy of the full results will be posted or emailed to all competitors within seven days of the finish of the event.

17. Protests



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No protests will be accepted.

18. Data Protection Act

Prospective entrants and competitors are advised that information supplied on the entry form will be held on a computer and used for the administration of the event. Details may be passed to other event organisers for the purpose of the circulation of event regulations. If you do not wish your details to be circulated, please indicate this on the entry form.
